# **Healthy Opportunity Pilot (HOP)**



#### What is HOP?

HOP is a program orchestrated by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS). **The intent behind this program is to address the medical and non-medical factors that drive health by having patients collaborate and achieve goals to help meet needs.** To be eligible for HOP services you must be a reside in an eligible county, have NC Managed Medicaid, and work with a Care Manager to enroll in services. If your PCP is JCMC as listed through the Department of Social Services you are eligible for both Care Management and HOP services, *free of charge*.

<u>To get started in HOP services, please contact the Care Management Team at 910-420-5553</u>. Your Care Manager will complete a referral for you and agencies in the local community will contact you to initiate services (following a brief assessment to ensure eligibility).
